The Southern Alberta Professional Development Consortium FNMI Advisory Committee has created a course on the SAPDC moodle site for the sharing of resources including lesson plans, websites, etc.

Educators across the province are invited to enroll in the course and are welcome to use any of the resources posted. Check back often as this is a work in progress and resources will be added.

Because this is a secure site there is a two-step registration process as follows:

1. **Create an account** on the moodle site.
2. Use an **enrollment key** to access the resource you want.

### **Registration:**

**First time Users** – go to <http://moodle.sapdc.ca> and follow the steps below:

1. Click on “Create new account” on the left hand banner and complete.
2. An email will be sent to you asking you to confirm your registration.
3. Select the FNMI course
4. You will receive a message indicating you need an **enrolment key**. To access the FNMI course please e-mail, [Ken.Hakstol@sapdc.ca](mailto:Ken.Hakstol@sapdc.ca) to obtain an **enrolment key**. You will receive the enrolment key from Ken via e-mail within a couple of days.
5. Once you have received the **enrolment key**, return to the moodle site <http://moodle.sapdc.ca> and login with username and password.
6. Choose the FNMI course. Enter the **enrolment key** and you will be enrolled in the course.
7. Note: You will not have to use the key again but you will need your username and password each time you enter the site.
