Last year the Southern Alberta Professional Development Consortium (SAPDC) participated in an exciting professional learning opportunity for teachers in Zone 6 implementing the revised Mathematics Program of Studies. SAPDC Mathematics Implementation Support Teachers, Bonnie Layton and Mary Jo Rawleigh, posted resources, web links, power points, and internet sites as well as lesson plans, assessment tools and activities to Division II, III, and IV Mathematics courses on the SAPDC model site for teacher use. Materials posted vary in the different divisions.

Although the courses are not being added to this year, the moodle site, and information posted in the courses last year, is now being made accessible to all Mathematics teachers across the province to continue to support teachers in implementing the revised Mathematics Program of Studies. All teachers across the province are invited to enroll in any, or all, of the courses and are welcome to use any of the information posted.

Because this is a secure site there is a two-step registration process as follows:

1. Create an account on the moodle site.
2. Use an **enrollment key** to access the resource you want.

Registration: "First time Users" please go to <http://moodle.sapdc.ca> and follow the steps below:

1. Click on "Create new account" on the left hand banner and complete.
2. An email will be sent to you asking you to confirm your registration.
3. Select your course
4. You will receive a message indicating you need an **enrolment key**. To access any of the Div I, II, III, or IV courses please email, Ken.Hakstol@sapdc.ca to obtain an **enrolment key**.
5. Once you've received the **enrollment key** return to the moodle site <http://moodle.sapdc.ca> login with username and password.
6. Choose the Resource/Course. Enter the **enrollment key** and you will be enrolled in the course. Note: You will not have to use the key again but you will need your username and password each time you enter the site.
