New to SMART Boards? Comfortable with a few of the tools but unsure of what you can do with the Notebook toolbar? This hands-on session will explore how to use SMART Tools, the Gallery and Lesson Activity Toolkit to create engaging resources for your classroom. Creative ideas and uses for SMART Boards will be presented, including whole class, small group and individual learning activities. You'll also look at online resources and how to customize existing files.
