- How to adapt commonly found math manipulatives so that students and their caregivers can do the math activities at home.
- How to close the achievement gaps and rebuild the months of learning students have lost due to Covid.
- How to differentiate the games and activities to meet the wide range of student needs in your virtual classrooms.
- How to use games and activities for assessment purposes in virtual settings.
- How to develop math journals to help capture student work.

During the workshop participants will play a variety of hands-on games and activities and learn teaching strategies that incorporate the use of easily found cards and dice – manipulatives that families can have on hand at home.
