Program

This is an introductory, practical learning session to support Kindergarten and Grade 1 teachers in the implementation of the new ELA foundational literacy curriculum to equip students for reading success. The focus will be on how to develop these key foundational skills:

- phonological awareness - spoken word, rhyming, alliteration, onset-rime, syllables
- phonemic awareness skills - phoneme identification, isolation, blending, segmenting, and manipulation
- phonics skills - letter formation, letter/sound association, decoding (sounding out)
- orthographic mapping - encoding (spelling); word memory retrieval

For the past three years, Dr. Karrah has also been collaborating with Harvard University in a research study on an innovative dyslexia screening technology developed by a multi-disciplinary team in Greece.
